### **Registration:**

Luce Hall Common Room, 34 Hillhouse, 2nd floor. Beginning at noon on Friday, Oct. 17. (Campus map is available at <http://www.yale.edu/campusmap/hillhouse.html>)

### **Getting to Yale:**

For travel directions to Yale Center for International and Area Studies, Henry R. Luce Hall, 34 Hillhouse Ave., New Haven:

#### By Personal or Rental Vehicle:

Interstate 91 from North, Hartford/Springfield: Take Exit 3, Trumbull Street. Straight off ramp, continue on Trumbull Street, through three traffic lights. Take first right, after the third light, onto Hillhouse Avenue. YCIAS/Luce Hall is the third building on the left.

Interstate 95 from South and West, NY/NJ: Connect to I-91 North in New Haven: Take Exit 3, Trumbull Street, and follow directions above for I-91.

Interstate 95 from North and East, Providence/New London: Connect to I-91 North in New Haven; Take Exit 3, Trumbull Street and follow directions above for I-91.

#### Parking:

On Friday, you can park in the Visitor Lot at after 4 PM without charge. Prior to 4 PM you will have to go to 155 Whitney Ave., 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Parking and Transit and purchase a one day parking pass for a cost of \$4.00. Parking on the street is for up to five hours and the meters take quarters.

On Saturday and Sunday, all of the campus lots are open for parking.

#### By Plane:

Tweed-New Haven Airport, (203 946-8283), is the closest airport and is approximately four miles from the Yale campus.

Taxi, bus, and car rental service is available.

The most convenient large airport is Bradley International; it is less than an hour away from Yale.

Other airports in the area are LaGuardia, JFK, and Newark. It is approximately a 2-3 hour drive from these airports to the Yale Campus. There is frequent bus service to New Haven from these airports via Connecticut Limousine. (See below).
